I would like to start by thanking everyone for their continued support over the year, as you may know our Community offer has undergone small changes and we thank everyone for their patience as this process has taken place. This years community sessions will finish and break for the Christmas period on **December 17th 2023** and will start back again on **January 12th 2024.**

As we now look into the New Year we would like to extend our Community offer even further, by introducing a Competitive League format alongside our existing Community sessions. Saturday morning

• Community session Boys 9:00-10:00am Year 7-11

Year 7/8 and Year 9-11 (Boys)

All Competitive League games will take place between 9:00am-12:00pm

Year 4-6 League (Boys)

All Competitive League games will take place between 6-8pm

All Community Sessions will be £3

Within this new structure, we would like to present **Mini-Ballers** on a Friday 4:45-5:30pm. Aimed at Reception age to Year 2 which is a brand new offer with a Multi-Skills focused session with Basketball elements imbedded, to improve children's Agility/Balance/Coordination.

How to join a team:

All League Games will be £4 but subject to change when teams are established and will become £30 per team
